CANADA SUMMER JOBS FUNDING APPLICATION

On Thursday, February 28, I submitted an application to Canada Summer Jobs for 2 full time summer students at O-YA. These positions would be a Senior Summer Youth Worker and a Summer Program Coordinator. Funding notifications will be made in May.

Very disappointingly, on Thursday, March 14, I received a call from Peggy Austin from the United Way to let me know that they are not able to continue O-YA's funding past March 31, 2013. As I have reported before, we were expecting this result as the United Way did not put out a call for proposals this year. There was some chance that, if they had exceeded their campaign goal, they could have continued our funding. But, this is not the case. They will be doing another Call for Proposals for 2014, and we will apply again. This, however, leaves us with a significant \$30,000 budget shortage in 2013.
